

Terms and Conditions: AEA Tick Roadshow Event Competition

July – August 2025

Entry Period: Entries for this competition begin on 18 July 2025 at 01:00 AM AEST and close on 24 August 2025 at 11:59 PM AEST. Entries submitted outside of this period will not be accepted. Only one entry per person is allowed. Any duplicate entries will be disqualified.
